Community Worker – Part Time - Hopedale

The successful applicant must have the ability to translate from Inuktitut to English and from English to Inuktitut in a legal setting which would include both in-office and court. The successful applicant must have the proven ability to communicate effectively with clients in both languages.

The challenges and responsibilities will include:

- Assisting with communications between clients and legal and support staff
- Assisting clients with making application for Legal Aid
- Assisting clients with reviewing and completing documents and forms
- Other client contact as necessary
- Travel as required

This position will be located in Hopedale under the supervision of the Area Director of the Happy Valley Goose Bay Office.

The salary for this position is \$28.08 per hour.
